WHAT TO DO IF THE ORDER IS VIOLATED.

WHAT IS AN ORDER OF PROTECTION?

An Order of Protection (OOP) is a legal order signed by a judge. THE PERSON

FILING/PETITIONING FOR THE

ORDER OF PROTECTION IS THE

"PETITIONER" AND THE

PERSON IT IS AGAINST IS THE

RESPONDENT

A POLICE REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED TO FILL OUT AN APPLICATION FOR AN OOP An OOP WILL NOT GO ON THE ABUSER'S/RESPONDENT'S RECORD AS LONG AS THEY ABIDE BY THE ORDER.

ONCE THE ORDER IS SIGNED BY
THE JUDGE, IT DEEMS ANY
CONTACT, DIRECT OR
INDIRECT, STALKING,
HARASSMENT, ETC. FROM THE
ABUSER/RESPONDENT- AN
ARRESTABLE CRIME.

UNDER AN ORDER OF
PROTECTION, AN
ABUSER/RESPONDENT
CAN BE ORDERED NOT TO:

THREATEN OR ABUSE THE
PETITIONER, THE PETITIONER'S
CHILDREN, OR THE
PETITIONER'S PETS

CONTACT THE PETITIONER, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, OR THE PETITIONER'S CHILDREN

INTERFERE WITH THE PETITIONER'S UTILITIES

OWN OR HAVE ACCESS TO FIREARMS

PETITIONER CAN ALSO ASK THE COURT

TO HAVE THE RESPONDENT
MOVE OUT OF PETITIONER'S
HOME IMMEDIATELY

TO ORDER THE RESPONDENT
TO PAY CHILD SUPPORT,
ALIMONY, AND/OR THE
HOUSEHOLD BILLS

TO SEPARATE YOUR CELL
PHONE LINES

FOR RESPONDENT NOT TO

COME AROUND THE

PETITIONER OR THE

PETITIONER'S CHILDREN, NO



HOW TO GET AN ORDER OF PROTECTION

GO TO THE CIRCUIT COURT

CLERK'S OFFICE TO FILE A

PETITION FOR THE ORDER OF

PROTECTION

BRING:

- An address for the respondent (home, workplace, school, etc.)
- THE RESPONDENT'S DATE OF BIRTH
- A PARENT OR GUARDIAN IF PETITIONER IS UNDER THE AGE OF 18

NOTE:

THE ORDER WILL GO INTO EFFECT UPON AN OFFICER SERVING THE RESPONDENT.

(THE RESPONDENT CAN'T BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR VIOLATING THE ORDER IF THEY DON'T KNOW IT EXISTS.)

WHAT TO DO IF THE ORDER IS VIOLATED

IF THERE IS IMMEDIATE DANGER
WHEN THE ORDER IS VIOLATED
OR THE PETITIONER IS AFRAID
FOR THEIR LIFE, CALL 911

IF THERE'S NO IMMEDIATE

DANGER AND THE PETITIONER

WANTS TO REPORT THE

VIOLATION, CALL THE LOCAL

POLICE DEPARTMENT.
